



Guidelines Free Speech and Peaceful Assembly

CSU Spur and its Vida, Terra, and Hydro buildings follow the CSU Policy for Free Speech and Peaceful Assembly and the CSU Policy for Special Events, except as otherwise provided and explained in these guidelines. These applicable policies can be found at:

Importantly, CSU Spur, its three buildings and the surrounding CSU property (collectively “CSU Spur”) are “non-public areas” as they are not open to the public for purposes of expressive activities or gatherings. CSU Spur is exclusively reserved for use by specific programs and for specific purposes, and CSU Spur limits the types of activities and uses. Demonstrations, amplified sound, disruptive noisemaking, chalking, posting and signage are prohibited in all CSU Spur areas, as is any activity that interferes with our functions. Persons refusing to vacate the CSU Spur premises upon request are subject to arrest under applicable municipal and state laws and may be subject to disciplinary action. Commercial expression is prohibited in all CSU Spur areas.
